

Associate Professor Khoon Lim is the Director of the Light Activated Biomaterials research group at the University of Otago Christchurch, New Zealand. He has generated >60 high impact journal publications (Chemical Reviews, Advanced Materials, Advanced Functional Materials), and raised a total of >\$NZD 5Million research grant funding as principal investigator. He has also won >20 competitive national and international awards, including the prestigious Jean Leray Award from the European Society for Biomaterials, Emerging Investigator Award from the Australasian Society for Biomaterials and Tissue Engineering, and Young Investigator Award from the International Society for Biofabrication. His research has also led to commercialisation of bioinks licensed to a US-based company. He is currently the President of the Australasian Society for Biomaterials and Tissue Engineering (ASBTE), Council Member of the New Zealand Association of Scientists, and Executive Board Member of the Medical Technologies Translator Programme. He currently sits on the editorial board of Macromolecular Bioscience, IOP Biomedical Physics & Engineering Express and Journal of Materials Science: Materials in Medicine.
